

Privacy and cookies policy

1. This Policy sets out the rules under which **Jamna Software sp. z o.o.** with its registered office in Stargard (ul. Powstańców Warszawy 10A/4, 73-110 Stargard), entered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register under number 0000848802, holding tax identification number (NIP): 8542432361, share capital of PLN 50,000, for which the registry court is the District Court Szczecin-Centrum in Szczecin, XIII Commercial Division of the National Court Register (hereinafter referred to as the „**Controller**”):
 - a) processes personal data of users of the website <https://softwarelogic.co/>, including its subpages (hereinafter: the „**Website**”),
 - b) uses cookies.
2. The Controller processes the user’s personal data via the Website only if the user uses the contact form placed on the Website.
3. The user’s data is processed by the Controller:
 - a) **on the basis of the consent of the data subject** (Article 6(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) [hereinafter: „**GDPR**”]),
 - b) **in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract, e.g. to provide an offer** (Article 6(1)(b) GDPR),
 - c) **in order to fulfil a legal obligation incumbent on the Controller** (Article 6(1)(c) GDPR),
 - d) **for purposes arising from the legitimate interests pursued by the Controller** (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR).
4. The Controller is entitled to perform the following personal data processing operations: collection, recording, storage, erasure or restriction of the processing of personal data.
5. The processing of personal data takes place in respect of:
 - a) data provided by the user in the contact form, including in particular: first name, last name, phone number, e-mail address, as well as other personal data disclosed in the content of the enquiry,
 - b) the user’s IP address.
6. The Controller may process personal data at least for the duration of the communication initiated by the submission of an enquiry via the form, and after its termination – for the time necessary to fulfil the legal obligation incumbent on it under generally applicable provisions of law.
7. The person whose data is being processed has the right to:
 - a) request from the Controller access to their personal data, their rectification, erasure or restriction of processing, as well as to object to their processing and to data transfer,
 - b) if the processing is based on consent – withdraw consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal,
 - c) file a complaint regarding the processing of personal data with the supervisory authority, which is the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (ul. Stanisława Moniuszki 1A, 00-014 Warszawa).

8. In order to exercise the rights referred to in point 7 letters a) and b), the person whose data is processed by the Controller, may contact the Controller at: office@softwarelogic.co.
9. The Controller does not make the user's personal data available to third parties; however, they may be processed by:
 - a) the hosting service provider enabling the operation of the Website, to the extent necessary for its proper functioning,
 - b) the internet service provider, to the extent necessary for establishing communication,
 - c) the provider of the service related to handling enquiries submitted via the contact form, to the extent necessary for receiving and processing their content,
 - d) providers of analytical services, to the extent necessary for creating page view statistics and traffic analysis.
10. The Website uses cookies (i.e. small text files that the server on which the Website operates sends to the user's browser and which the browser sends back when visiting the Website) in order to collect information related to the user's use of the Website. These files enable:
 - a) maintaining the user's session,
 - b) adjusting the display settings of subpages to the user's needs,
 - c) creating page view statistics and traffic analysis.
11. The user may at any time change the settings concerning cookies by appropriately configuring the settings of the web browser they use. These settings may be configured, among other things, in such a way as to block the automatic handling of cookies or to inform about each download of them by the user's device.
